What are you saying?

What you say affects your life much more than most people think.

Matthew 12:36-37: But I say to you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment. For by your words you will be judged, and by your words you will be condemned.

Chilling words, but words we must believe the same as we embrace ... For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son that whosoever believes should not perish but have everlasting life (John 3:16).

Many Christians believe our God is able to do what we ask or say. What most Christians do not understand is how He does it. God gave us the authority and ability to curse a fig tree, move a mountain, slay a giant, and calm a storm. Most Christians know how to agree with fear more than they know how to operate in faith.
