If you are paying any attention to the prophets or the signs of the times as the sons of Issachar did, you know that we are needing to prepare for perhaps the greatest move of God that has ever been witnessed on earth. My recommendation is for us to take this small window of grace to make ready our own hearts.

The anointing does not begin in your ministry; it begins in your relationship with God.

Your personal devotional life and study of God's Word builds the character and faith you need to handle the anointing. The novice will find it is too hot to handle. They will drop the ball and fail as many before them have.

I believe that something like 80% of our secret place time needs to be in His presence right now. The other 20% will be anointed and sufficient for the work God has for us to do.

A lot of pastors and leaders have a great working relationship with Jesus but a lousy (poor) personal relationship with Him. That is just not going to be successful in the coming days. You need the anointing of fire, and you need to be able to handle it! It is coming. Are you ready?

If you are not ready, your ministry will burn out quickly. If your ministry is based on what you are doing, rather than who you are doing it for, you will burn out, burn up or blow up!

Your primary anointing is to know God; know His love; know the Prince of Peace and enter His presence and rest! Then, my friend, you actually are anointed to help someone!

I am trying to energize your devotional time into a much higher level of intimacy with God. This is a time of refreshing for you! A call to intense and deep friendship with Jesus through the Holy Spirit...more than you have ever known of the love of the Father.

I believe that there is a quickening, an anointing, of the Holy Spirit where He can teach you five years of growth in this short time we have together. Not one of us is where we want or need to be; we all can and will advance according to the opportunities we take in the coming days.
